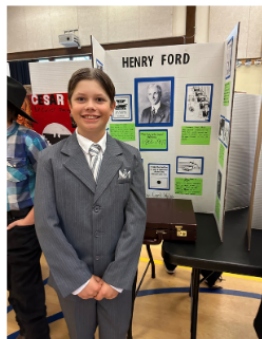


HISTORY COMES ALIVE
