STATE ACADEMIC TESTING

Next month, our 3rd through 8th grade students will be participating in the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP). This will assess English-Language Arts. mathematics, and science (5th/8th). Our first official day of testing will be Monday, April 14th, with our 6th graders. A detailed schedule for all grades will be distributed soon. The school and grade level results is one of many important data points to review how our school is doing. We also use this data to compare ourselves with the schools in our County (we don't like losing to any of them) and at the State level. Our teachers are working hard to prepare our students to show grade level proficiency.
